New Measures facilitating Architectural and Engineering Sectors to start business and practise in the Greater Bay Area



The Development Bureau has announced new measures to facilitate enterprises and professionals in starting businesses and practising in the nine cities of the Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Greater Bay Area (GBA).

The new measures would allow consultant firms on two Government lists, namely AACSB and EACSB, as well as professionals registered with relevant registration boards, to be able to directly provide services in the nine Mainland cities of the GBA by obtaining equivalent qualifications in the Mainland through a registration system.






