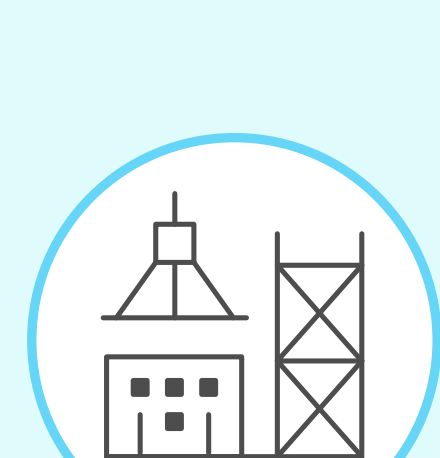
The HKTDC launched the “Infrastructure Tool Kit” to facilitate projects along the Belt and Road
